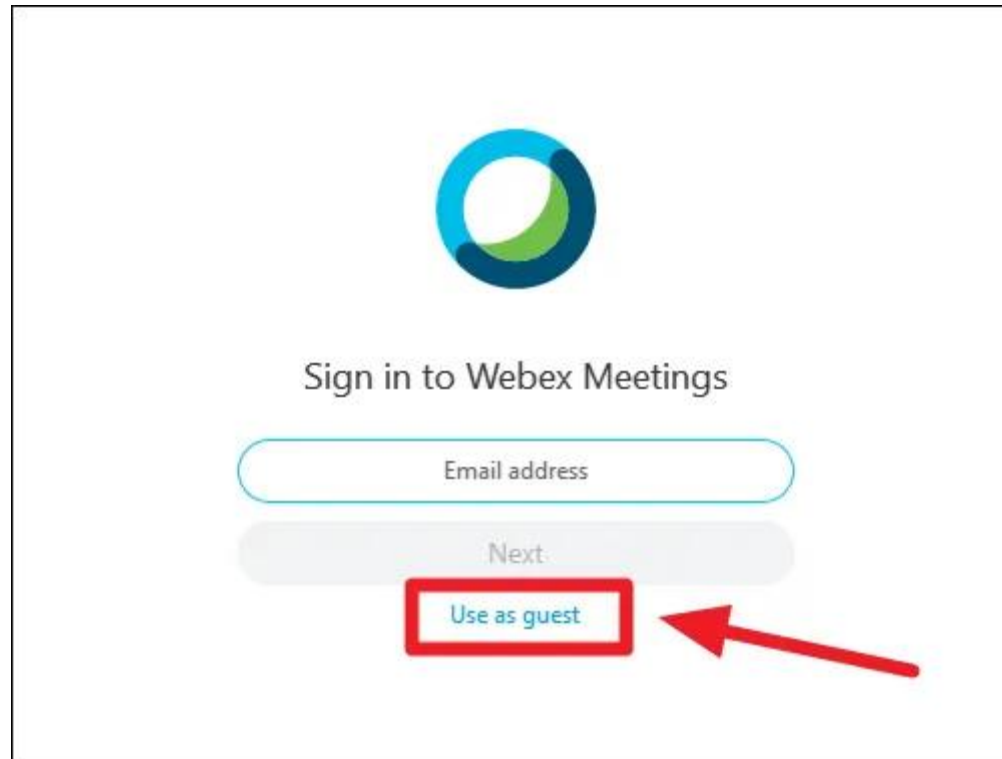



To download the application, please click on the following [LINK](#), then click on the Download button and install the application.

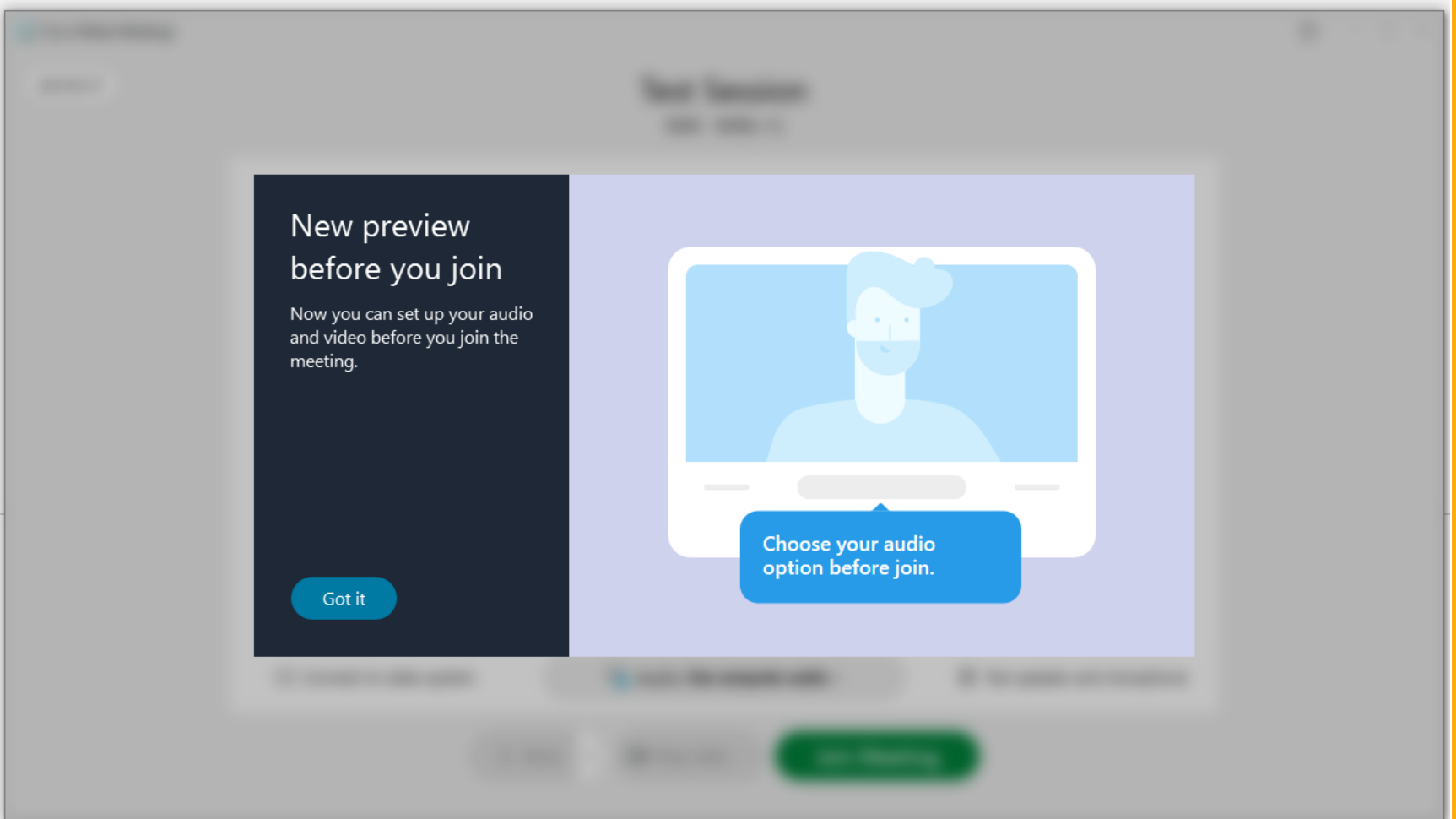
